IS MODERN LASIK PAINFUL?

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT AFTER LASIK?

You will notice improved, yet somewhat blurry vision as soon as you sit up from your procedure. But before you can use that new vision, you will be asked to go home and take a long nap (3-4 hours) to give your eyes a rest. You will come back for a quick post-operative follow-up within a few days following your procedure. Most patients are back to normal activities the next day!

HOW LONG DOES THE PROCEDURE TAKE?

The LASIK procedure itself is very fast, with most patients being in the OR for 10-15 minutes and the laser application taking only a few minutes.

LIFETIME VISION PLANS

While most patients only need Modern LASIK once, for a small percentage, a touch-up or enhancement procedure may be required to fine-tune their results. All LASIK.com providers offer lifetime vision plans where medically approved enhancement procedures are free-of-charge.

CONDITIONS WE CAN TREAT:

- **Astigmatism:** An overall blurriness at any distance caused by the cornea having multiple points of distortion.
- **Farsightedness:** Blurriness in distance vision caused by the cornea being too steeply curved.
- **Nearsightedness:** Blurriness in close vision caused by the cornea being too flat.

LASER VISION CORRECTION PROCEDURES

Modern LASIK using Custom Wavefront technology

WaveLight refractive technology combines surgical advancements into a LASIK procedure that can be personalized for your ideal vision. This system offers a unique and customized procedure that accounts for the unique optical characteristics of your cornea. As a result, Modern LASIK with Wavefront optimized or topography guided refractive technology aims to improve your overall quality of vision and maintain the natural asphericity (curvature) of your cornea to achieve improved contrast sensitivity. With Modern LASIK, the corneal flap creation is completed by a femtosecond laser as well, offering advantages like precision, consistency, and enhanced healing.

PRK: Photo Refractive Keratectomy

The process of the laser application to reshape the cornea is the same with PRK as it is with Modern LASIK. The difference is in the cornea preparation. Instead of

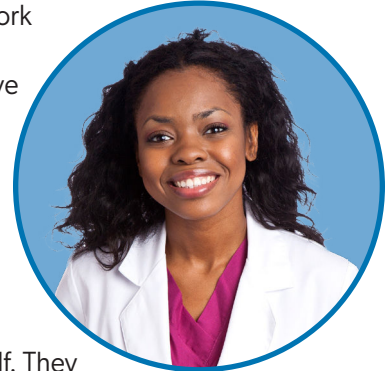


the flap being created by a laser, the cornea is gently wiped from the eye before the laser application to reshape the cornea. While a high majority of patients are candidates for Modern LASIK, PRK is available as an option for those with certain eye conditions preventing LASIK from being the optimal option.
